

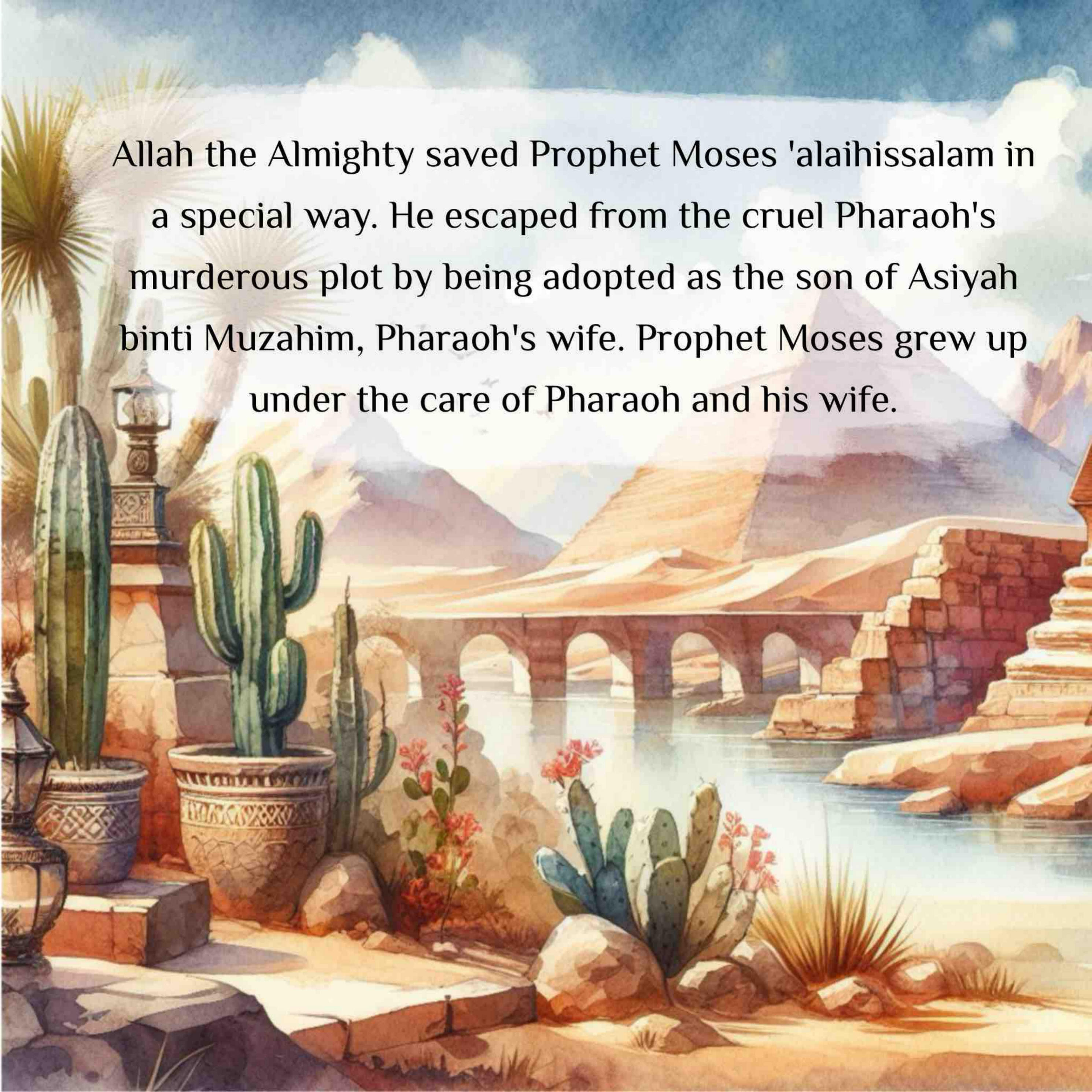





Allah the Almighty saved Prophet Moses 'alaihi salam in a special way. He escaped from the cruel Pharaoh's murderous plot by being adopted as the son of Asiyah binti Muzahim, Pharaoh's wife. Prophet Moses grew up under the care of Pharaoh and his wife.





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He became afraid of being punished for murder, he ran away to Midian. It was during this time that Allah the Almighty chose him to be a prophet. Prophet Moses was commanded to call upon people to worship Allah the Almighty alone.

After that, Allah the Almighty sent Prophet Moses to confront Pharaoh, who had exceeded all limits in his disbelief. Prophet Moses understood the weight of the task he was given and prayed

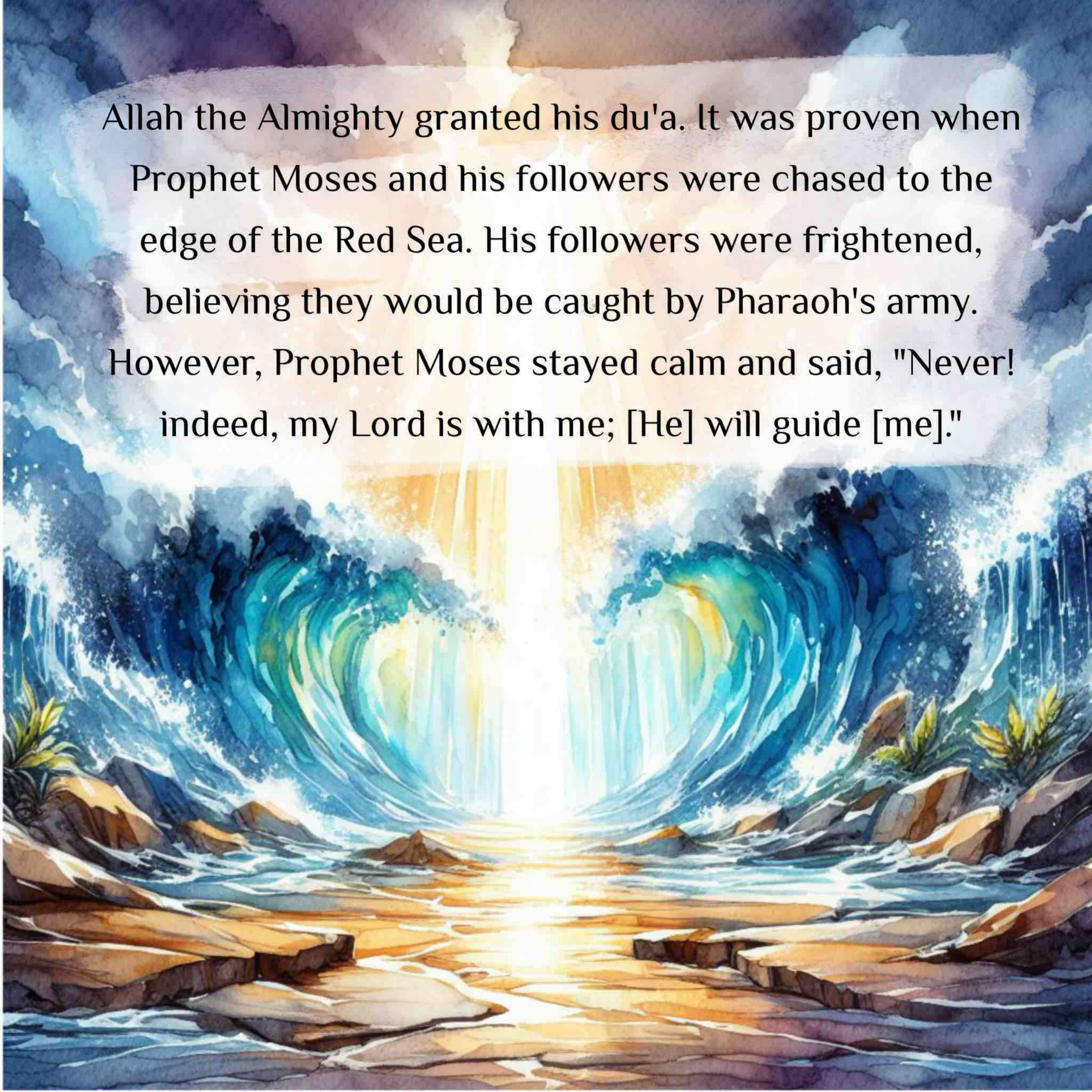
رَبِّ أَشْرَحْ لِي صَدْرِي

He continued his du'a,

وَيَسِّرْ لِي أَمْرِي

"And make easy for me my affairs."



Prophet Moses had been commanded to deliver a difficult message. He was sent to his foster father, a tyrannical king who was the most violent in his disbelief and had a large army. Prophet Moses knew that no one could make his task easier except Allah the Almighty.

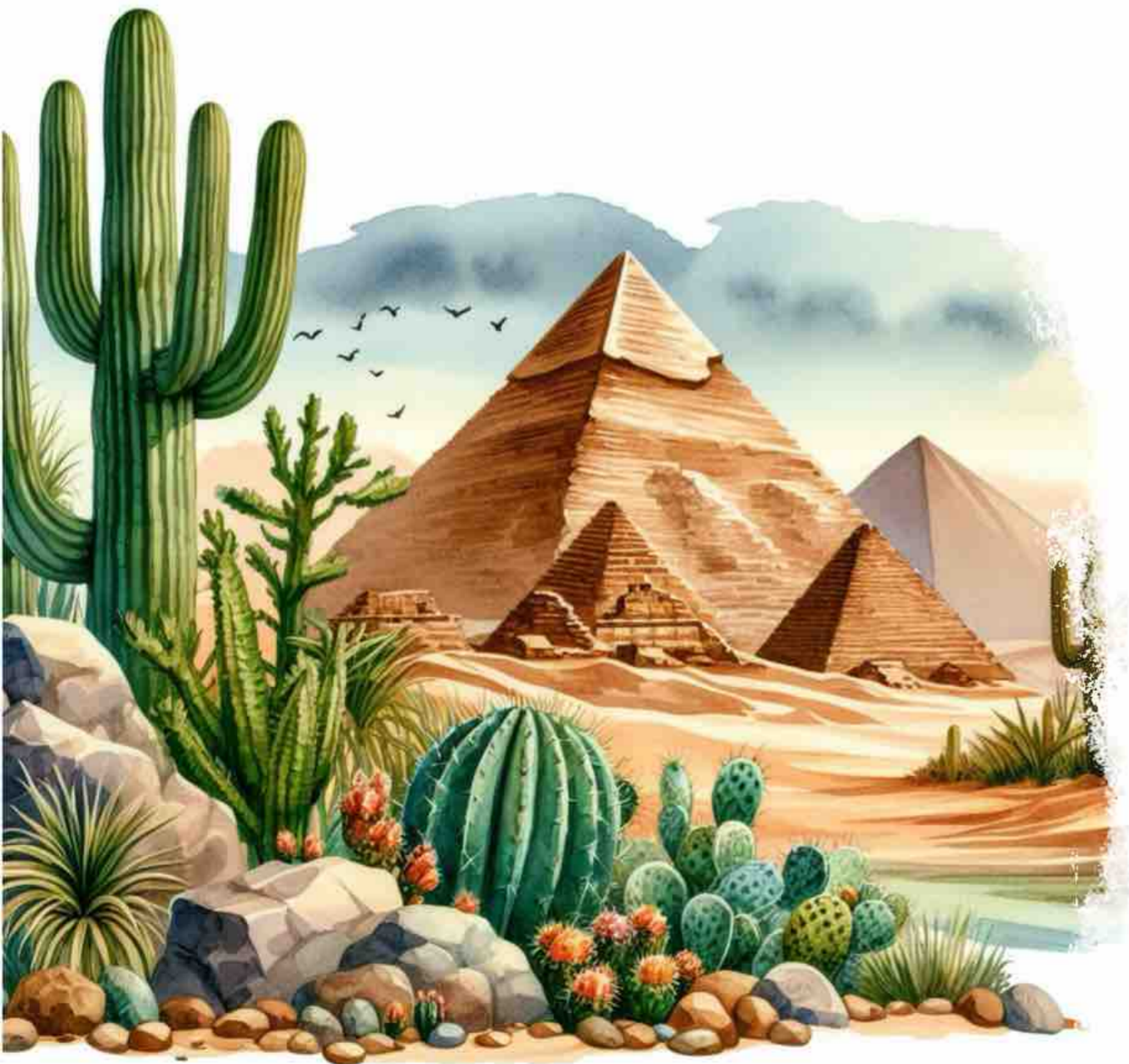



His du'a continued,

وَأَحْلُلْ عُقْدَةً مِّن لِّسَانِي  
يَفْقَهُوا قَوْلِي

"And remove the stiffness from my tongue that they  
may understand my words."

He asked Allah to remove the difficulty from his speech. Some scholars believe that Prophet Moses had trouble speaking, so his words were not easily understood by others.

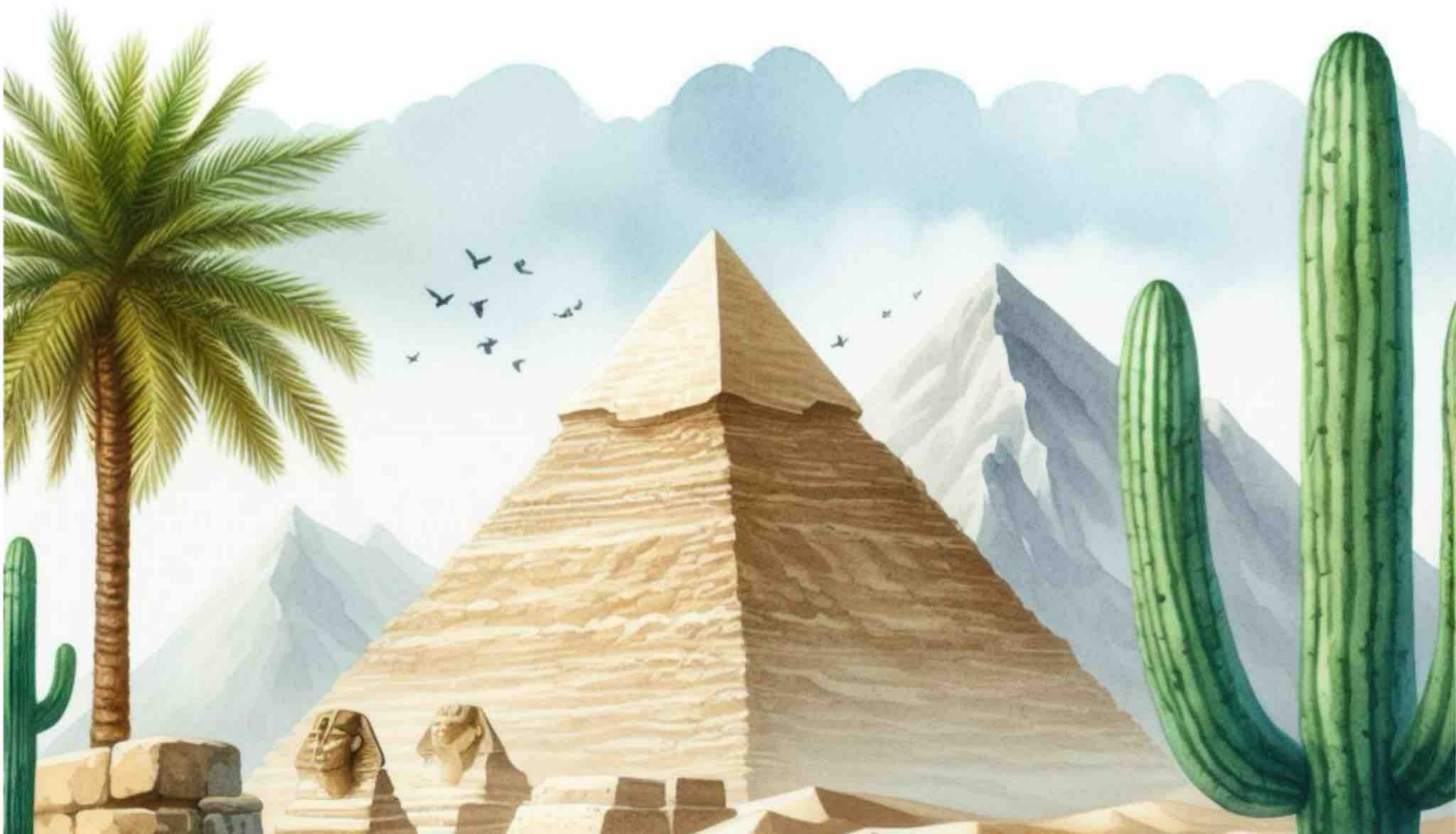

وَأَجْعَلْ لِي وَزِيرًا مِّنْ أَهْلِي

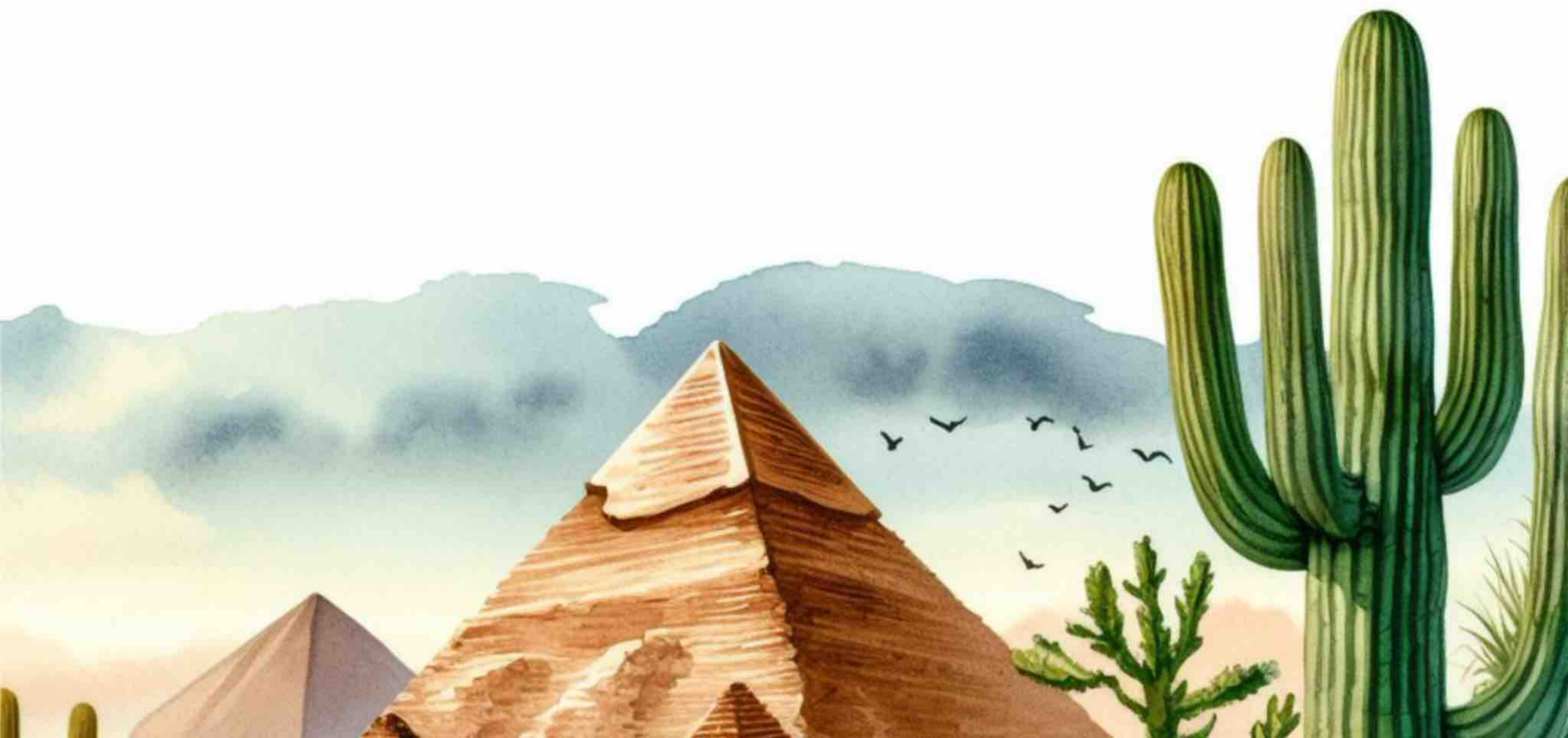
هَارُونَ أَخِي

"And appoint for me a helper from my family, Aaron, my brother. Strengthen my back with him and let him share my tasks."


Prophet Moses asked for his brother, Aaron, to also be appointed as a prophet. Allah the Almighty granted his request. Aaron was appointed as a prophet to accompany and strengthen the message of Prophet Moses. Aaron was older than Prophet Moses, as he was his elder brother.

"So that we may abundantly glorify You and remember

With Aaron being appointed as a prophet, Prophet Moses hoped that they could help each other in goodness and piety. Therefore, there would be more recitation of remembrance to Allah from both of them, such as tasbih, tahlil, and other forms of worship.

إِنَّكَ كُنْتَ بِنَا بَصِيرًا

"Indeed, You are the All-Seeing of us."

Prophet Moses concluded his prayer by seeking Allah's help and mentioning His attribute as the All-Seeing. Allah sees the condition of Prophet Moses, knows his weaknesses, and understands how much he needs Allah's assistance. Therefore, Prophet Moses asked Allah to grant his prayer. This is one of the etiquettes of du'a, which is praising Allah using His names and attributes, with the heart always realizing how much we need His help, and acknowledging that we have no power or ability except with His assistance.

Such is the beautiful du'a from Prophet Moses 'alaihissalam. May we learn valuable lessons from it. May Allah bless you all.
