

# Let's Talk Nicely!

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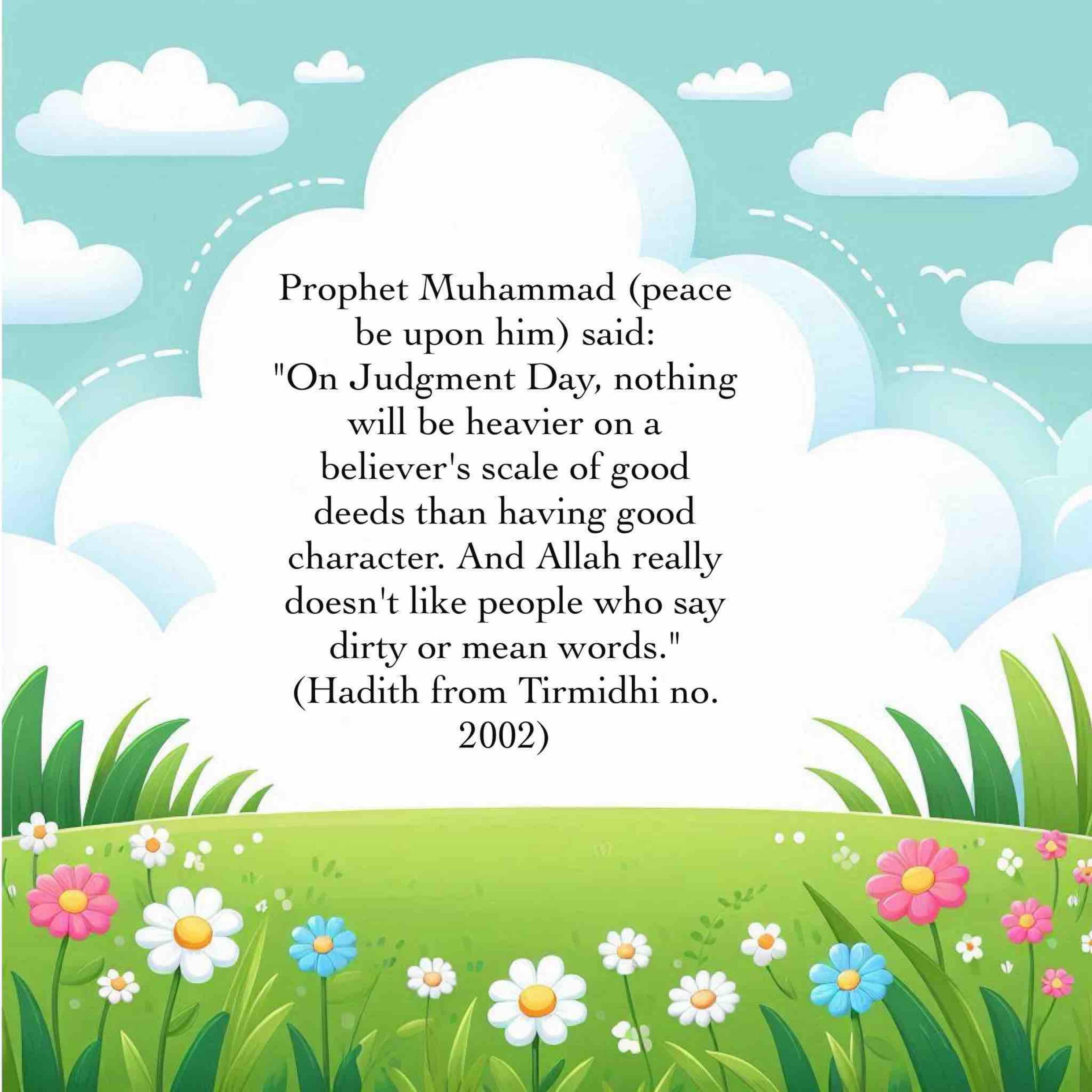
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Hey friends, did you know that talking nicely is something we need to practice? When we often say good things, our mouths get used to saying nice and happy things!



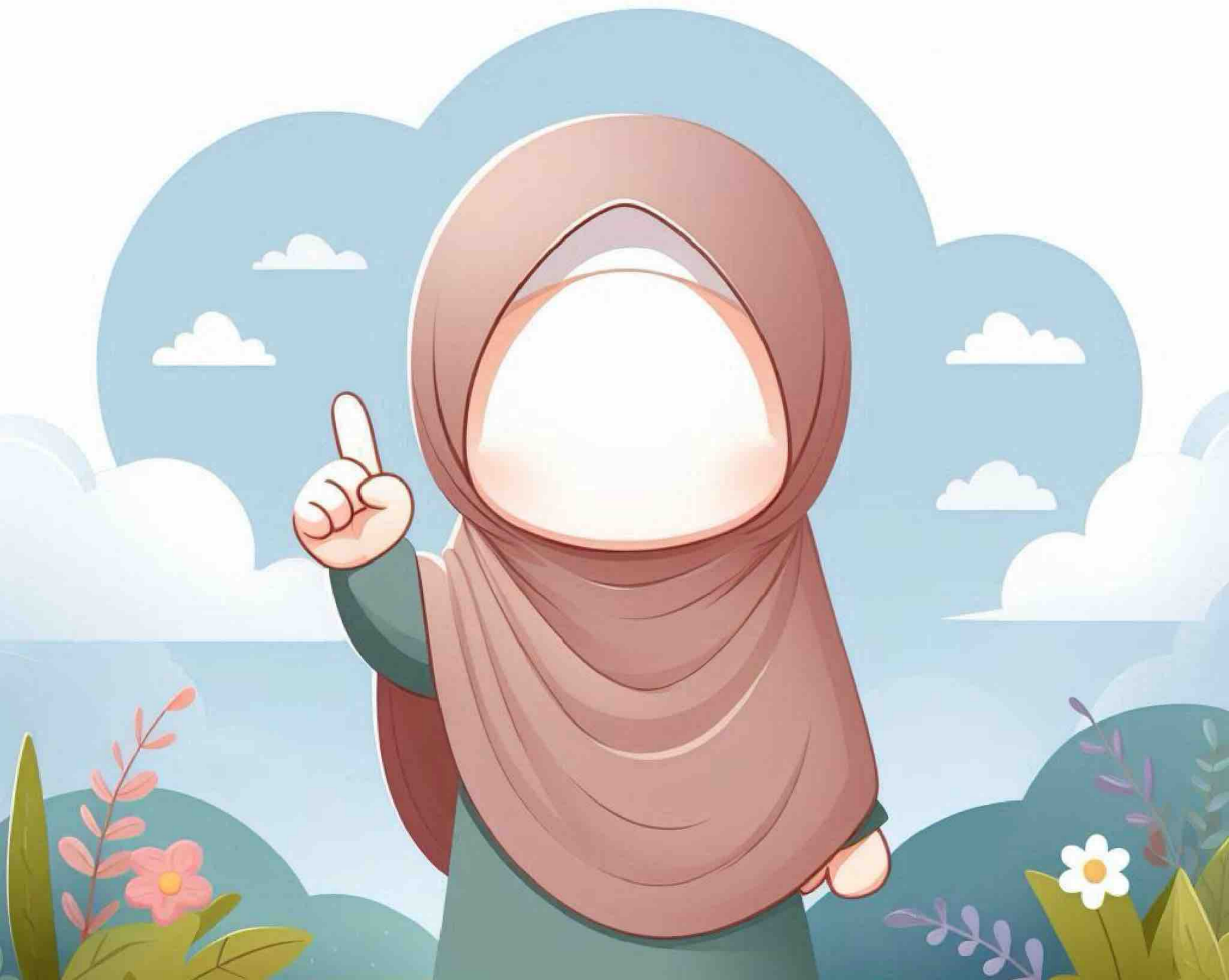


But beware... if we often talk mean, like

can become a habit too!



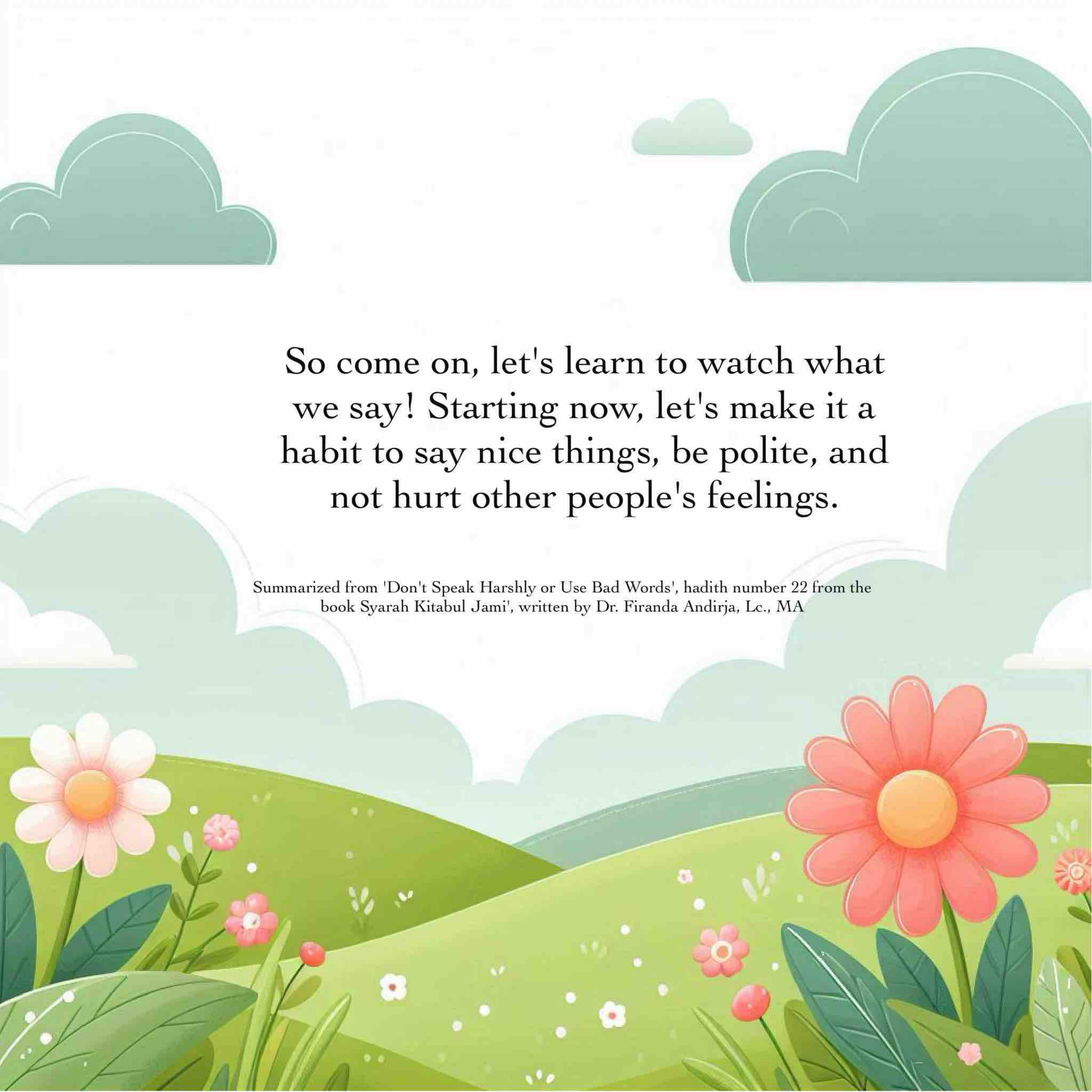
Prophet Muhammad (peace  
be upon him) said:  
"On Judgment Day, nothing  
will be heavier on a

deeds than having good  
character. And Allah really  
doesn't like people who say  
dirty or mean words."  
(Hadith from Tirmidhi no.  
2002)

So from this hadith, we learn that one way to recognize someone with good character is by listening to how they talk.



A good Muslim, even when giving advice or telling the truth, should still speak in a gentle and polite way. A good Muslim don't make fun of people, tease them, or embarrass them. Because Allah doesn't like that kind of talking.
