




# I Can't Wait for Ramadan

Heaven opens wide its doors by Allah's command.




I can't wait for Ramadan, each day I try to be,  
Doing good with the right intention, as pure as can be.




I can't wait to fast and do my part,  
It makes my iman grow strong in my heart.




No food and no drink from dawn till the sun goes down.

A blessed meal shared under the shining moon.




Suhoor is precious, I don't want to miss,

I'll stay focused to read it till the last page in Ramadan.




Storybooks and games can wait,
