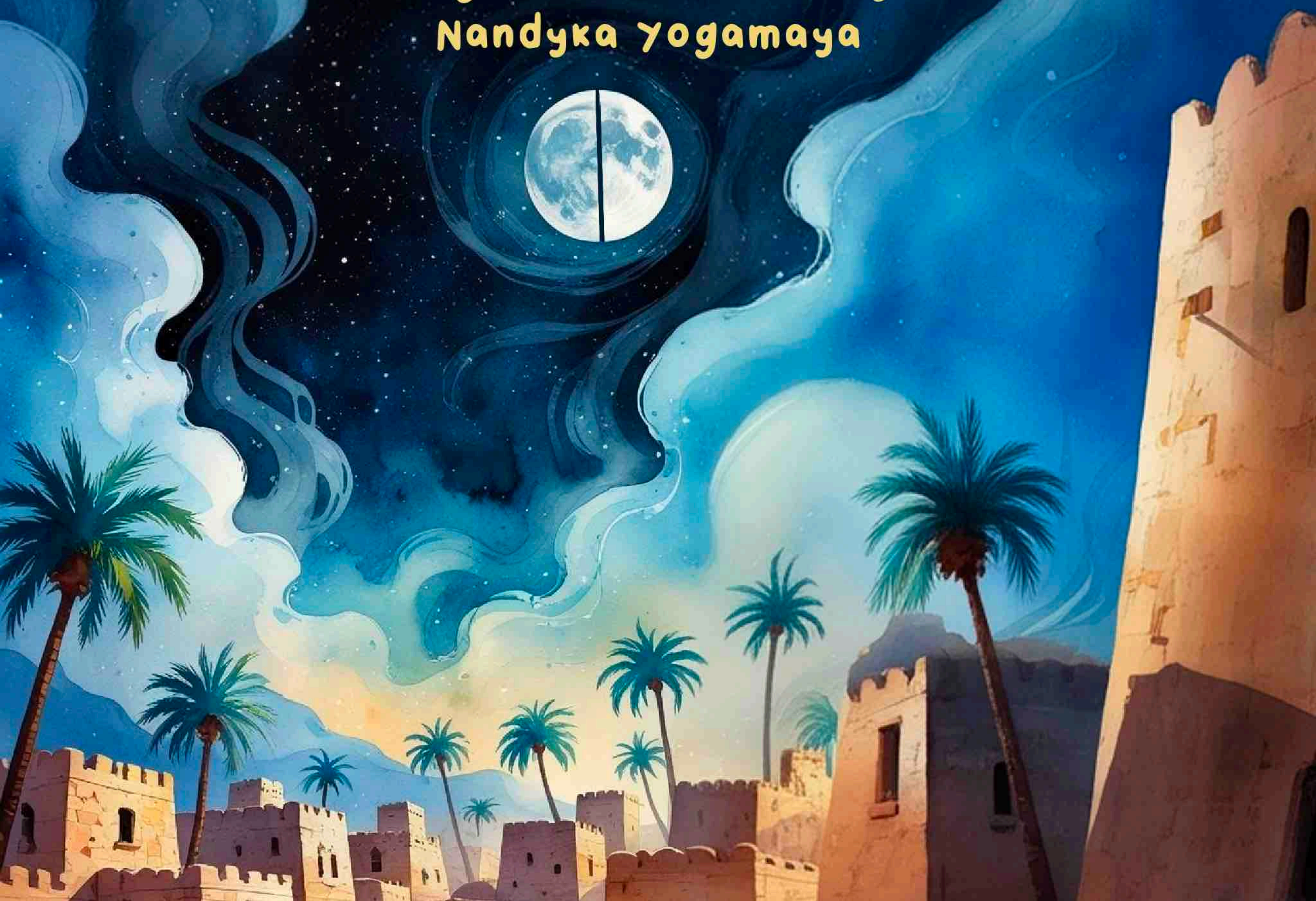


# The Moon Split in Two

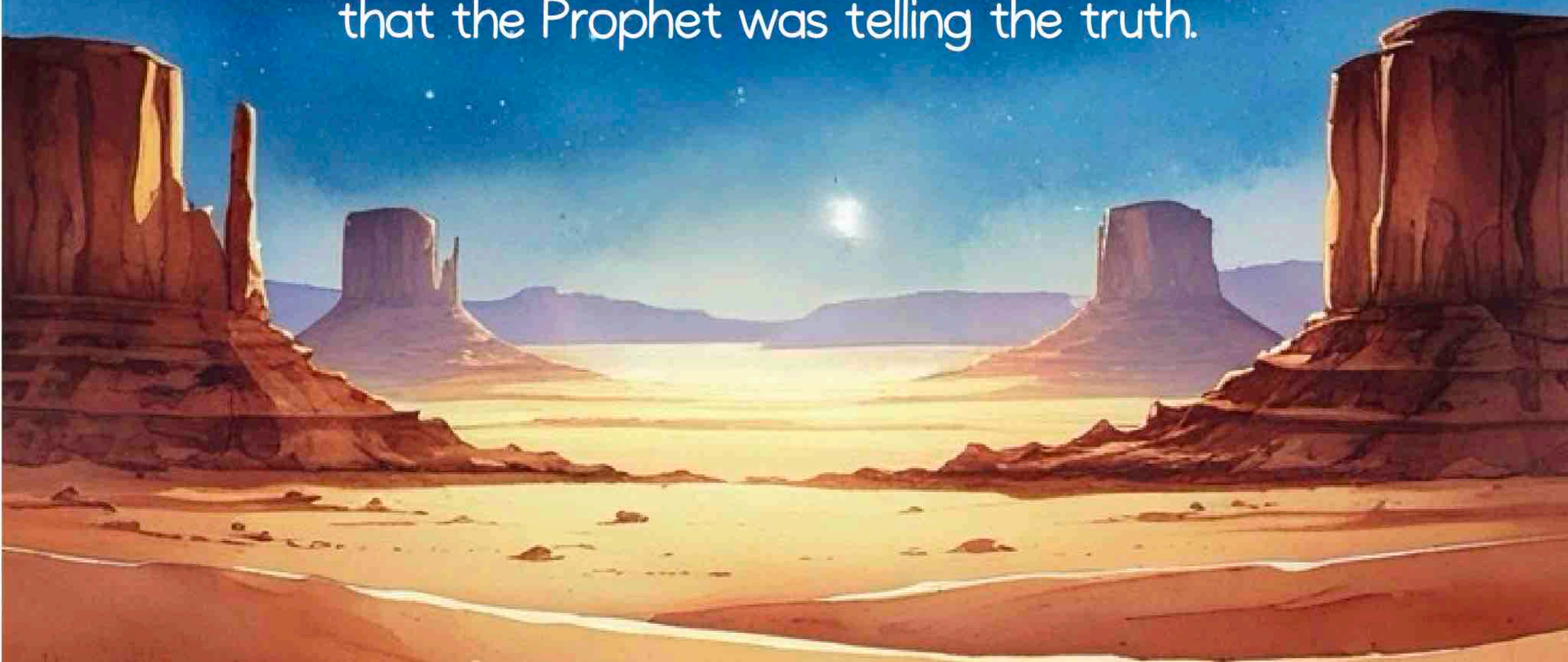

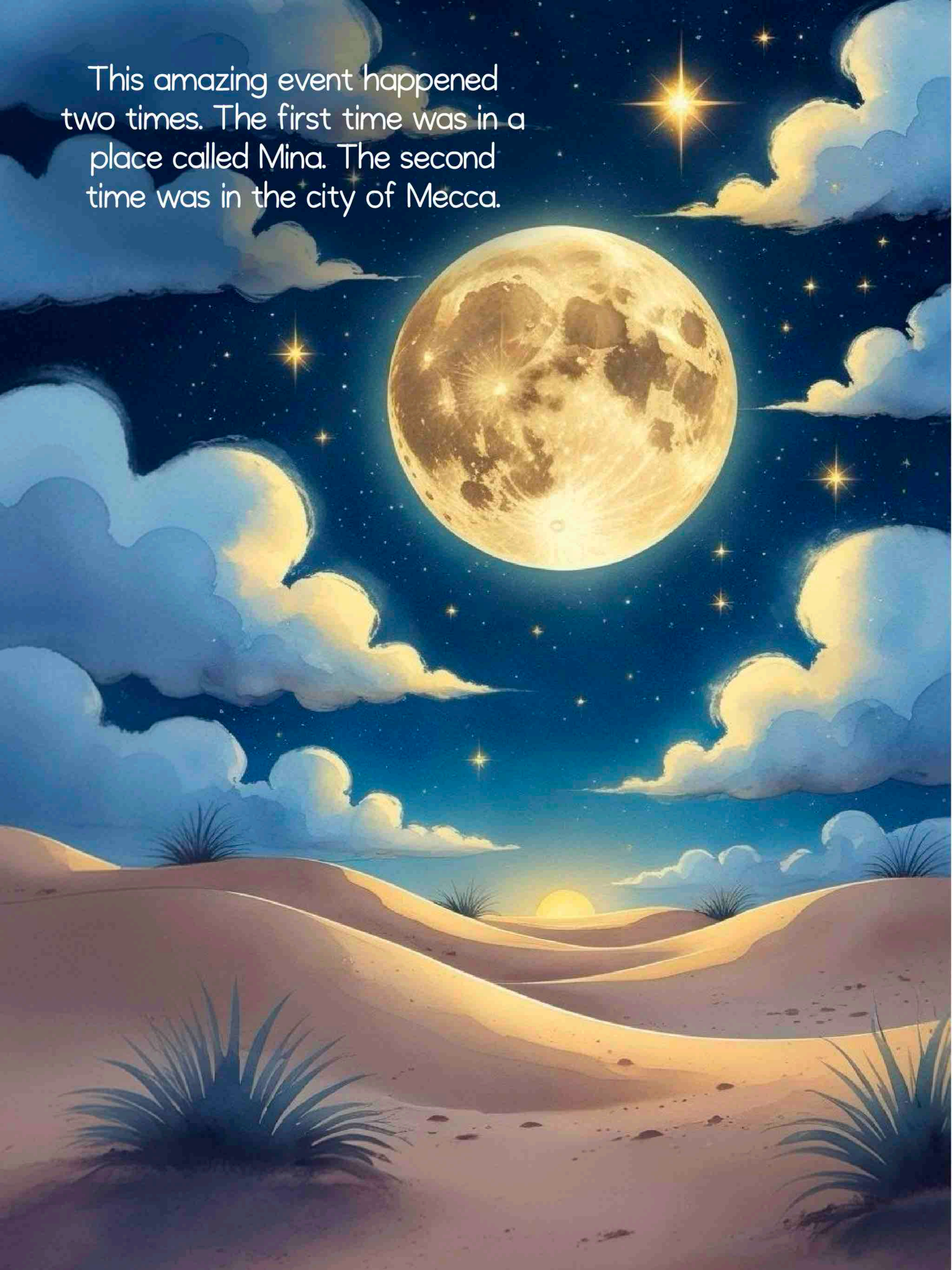

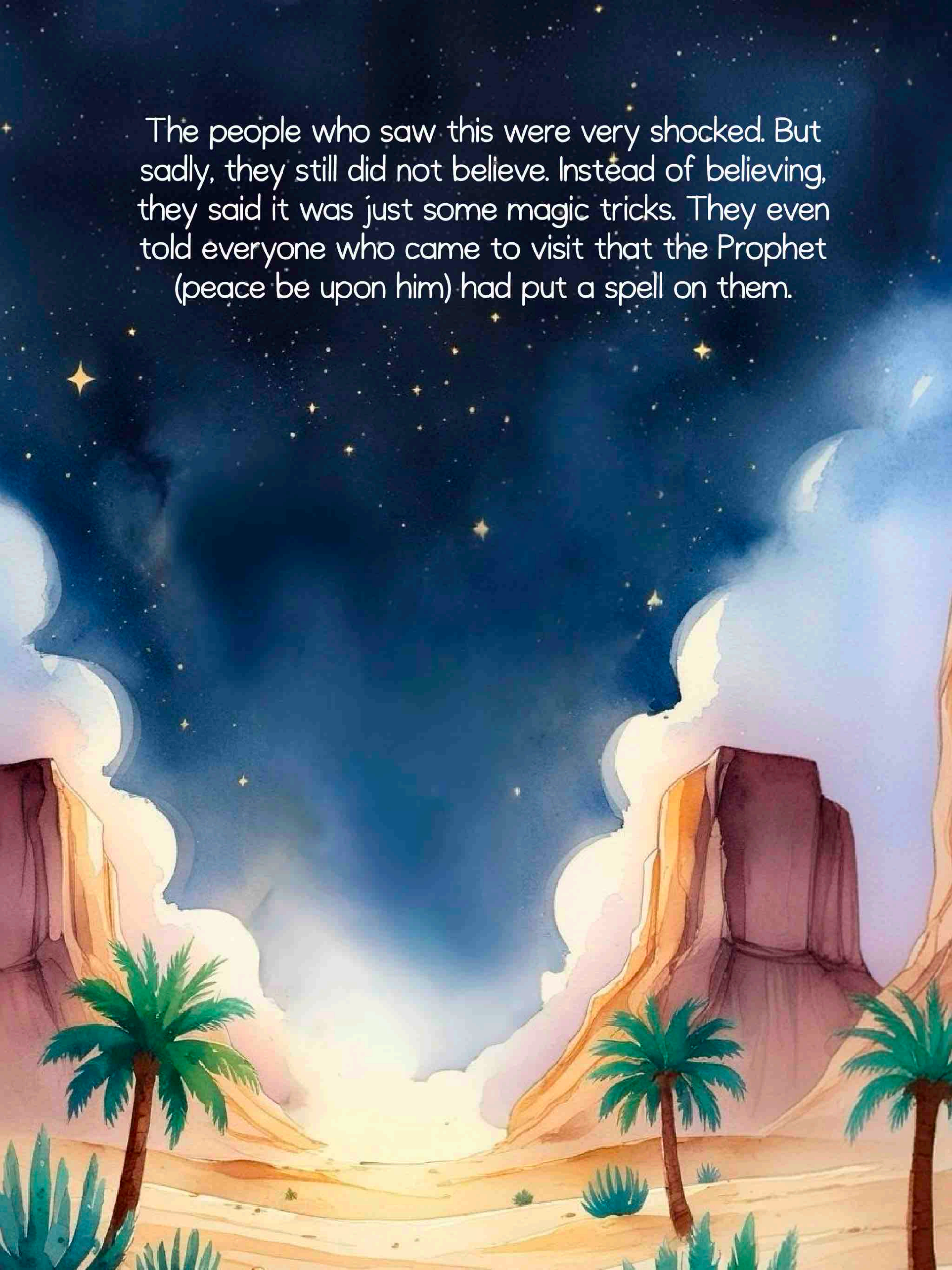


This amazing event happened

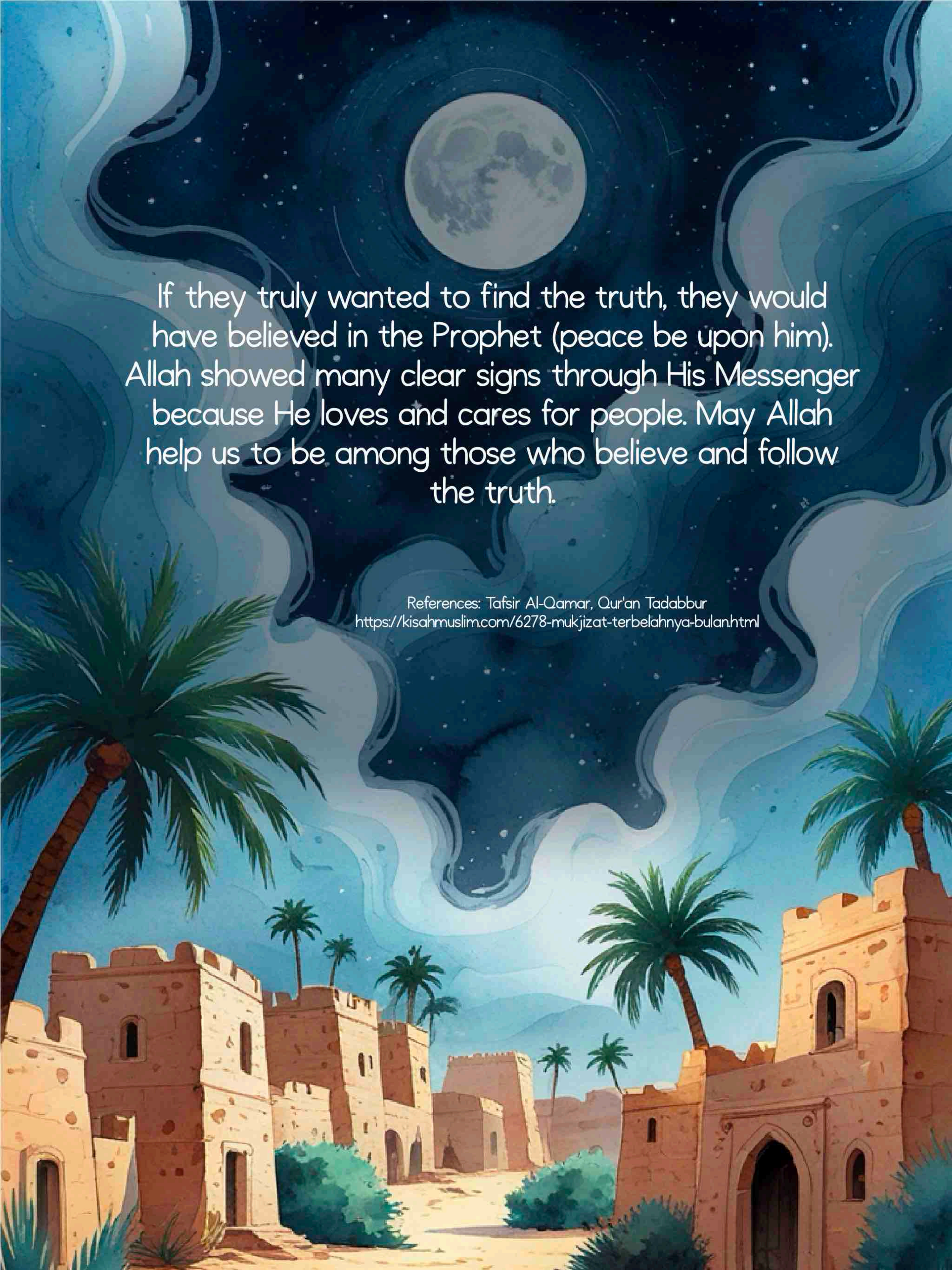
